The Belmont Report (1979)

Belmont Principles:

- Respect for Individuals - (*Informed Consent*)
- Beneficence - (*Do No harm & Maximize Benefits*)
- Justice - (*Fairness in Distribution*)



Community-Engaged Research Definition

- Community-engaged research is “the process of working collaboratively with groups of people affiliated by geographic proximity, special interests, or similar situations with respect to issues affecting their well-being.”

- Dissemination

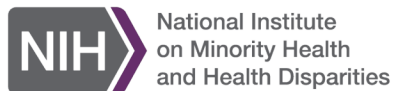
