

Locating Percentage of All Undergraduate Students Supported by Pell Grants in the NCES IPEDS system.

This document summarizes how to locate the percentage of all undergraduate students supported by Pell Grants in the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS).

1. Go to the IPEDS webpage: <https://nces.ed.gov/ipeds/search>
2. From the menu at the top of the page, click on “Find Your College”, then “Search for College”.
3. Type the name of your institution and/or enter other search criteria in the box on the upper left side of the page to find your institution:
